Preliminary Conditions for lead batteries supply

1. The bidder (Israeli) and the companies (Israeli) represented by him shall have all the necessary permits required by law, each in his own field, with regard to handling "lead batteries" in the following activities: storage, treatment (such as recycling) , production, importing, transportation, commerce and marketing, including:

- Business Licensing Act, 1968, and its derived regulations.
- Hazardous Materials Handling Act, 1993, and its derived regulations.
- Transportation Services Act, 1997, and its derived regulations.

* The bidder (Israeli) shall enclose to his bid, copies of the hazardous materials handling permit (including a list of materials - permit's first appendix), Business license, and the transporting license; for his own business as well as the companies that he represents in his bid (subcontractors) , each in his own field.

2. for purposes of transport, the bidder (Israeli) or its behalf (Israeli) must hold a business license for general transport according to Item 10.10D of the Business Licensing Order, 1968, in relation to the location at which the primary activity of the bidder is conducted or, according to the bidder's declaration, pursuant to the position of the relevant local authority, the bidder or its behalf, is not required to hold a business license according to Item 10.10D of the Business Licensing Order, 1968.

Alternatively, the bidder commits that, if he awarded the Tender, he will join by a contract with a transporter that meets all requirements of the law, including the requirements of the Business Licensing Order, 1968.

The Offeror must enclose to its proposal a declaration according to the format enclosed as Appendix 5 of this document.

3. The Israeli bidder is to sign a "Bidder declaration on lead batteries handling permit for tenders" attached as Appendix 1 of the contractual conditions document.
4. The bidder is to enclose to his bid a declaration by the manufacturer (if non Israeli), regarding environmental and occupational health protection (Appendix 2). Alternatively, the bidder shall enclose a certificate attesting the fact that the manufacturer maintains an environmental management system according to international standard, such as ISO 14001. The certificate must be valid for the tender requirements and time, and signed by The International Accreditation Forum Multilateral Recognition Arrangements IAFMLA body member.
5. The bidder is to sign a "Bidder's declaration regarding the removal of used/damaged lead batteries" attached as Appendix 3 of the contractual conditions document.
6. The bidder will attach to his offer a certificate from the Ministry of Environmental Protection, which allowed him to deal with lead batteries waste, including transportation, storage and disposal to approved company and principal letters of consent from these destinations confirming their agreement to accept the batteries waste.

Contractual conditions

1. For the entire validity period of the contract, the winner of the tender (if Israeli) is responsible for holding all permits required by law with regard to storage, transportation, commerce and marketing of hazardous materials ,including:
 - Business Licensing Act, 1968, and its derived regulations.
 - Hazardous Materials Handling Act, 1993, and its derived regulations.
 - Transportation Services Act, 1997, and its derived regulations.
2. During the entire validity period of the contract, the winner of the tender may employ subcontractors, which must hold the permits required for complying with his contractual obligations, provided that the subcontractors, each in his own field of expertise, hold the permits required by law, and provided that the winner has received approval by the IEC in advance on this subject, including when subcontractors are added during the period of the contract.
3. Article 2 (above) does not reduce the responsibility of the tender winner about his obligations according to the contracts articles.
4. The winner of the tender must inform IEC on the cancellation or non-renewal of any of his permits, including the hazardous materials permit, business license, transportation license, and any other environmental permit, which is applicable for this contract.
5. The IEC is entitled to cancel the agreement with the winner of the tender in case of cancellation or non-renewal of the hazardous materials permit, business license, or the transportation license, for his own company and for any of his subcontractors.
6. It is hereby clarified that a condition for starting the contract with the winning supplier is obtaining approval from the environmental protection ministry for the specific waste included in this tender to be disposed/removed by the winning supplier. If there is no approval from the ministry during 90 days, IEC has the right to cease the business association with the supplier that has been awarded the tender.

7. Safety sheets, packaging, labelling, marking –

- 7.1. In case of portable containers, the supplier is responsible to supply the hazardous material to the IEC sites, in the original manufacturer packaging only.
- 7.2. In case of portable containers, the winning supplier will provide in each delivery packages marked in accordance with Israeli Standard SI 2302, June 2004, ICS CODE: 13.300, "Dangerous substances and preparations - Transportation: Classification, packaging, labeling and marking" (Appendix 4).
- 7.3. The supplier (if Israeli) is responsible to provide, at any time, and with every update by the manufacturer, an updated safety sheet according to the Israeli regulations: Safety in the Workplace Regulations (Safety sheets, Packaging, Labeling, Marking), 1998.
- 7.4. The supplier (if non-Israeli) will provide an updated material safety data sheet according to the 91\155\EEC directive, including the updated version with every update by the manufacturer.

The safety data sheet will be supplied in magnetic media as well as hardcopy.

8. Loading and Unloading

The supplier will perform the loading and unloading of the lead batteries at the designed places according to IEC procedures, relevant IEC safety instructions and the instructions of the IEC representative on site.

9. Disposal of used/damaged lead batteries:

8.1 the supplier is responsible to remove used batteries from the active site in accordance with the conditions of this tender, and in coordination with the environmental protection approval. The removal shall be done in 6 days from receiving the removal request.

8.2 In case the supplier do not accept to remove the used/damaged batteries, IEC has the right to remove it at the supplier's expense.

8.3 The supplier shall remove the batteries waste to a facility approved by the ministry of environmental protection.

8.4 The supplier shall transfer to IEC a filled waste removal form (as updated in environmental protection ministry site) signed from all parties, during ten days from the removal day from IEC sites.

8.5 IEC reserves the right to cease the business association with supplier that has been awarded the tender in case that the supplier does not provide these certificates as required, on a regular basis, and/ or it is discovered that he is removing the used/damaged Batteries to a site that is not authorized by the Ministry of Environmental Protection.

9. Environmental incident

9.1 The supplier is responsible for the handling of all environmental incident, during the transport of the batteries

9.2 The supplier is responsible for the handling any environmental incident with hazardous materials (leakage, spill and so on) that may occur during loading, unloading or launching of the batteries.

9.3 The handling of the incident will be according to the manufacturer's material safety data sheet, and inside IEC sites; the handling of the incident will be also according to the safety procedures of IEC.

9.4 The supplier is responsible to remove any waste resulting from the incident to a site authorized by the ministry of environmental protection. The evacuation of the waste will be documented according to law.

9.5 The supplier is responsible to restore the site and return it to the state prior to the damage.

10. The supplier is totally responsible for any damages, due to damage or loss from any other kind following environmental damage due to its activity, including environmental incident with hazardous materials (leakage, spill and so on) during the handling of the lead batteries, or to legal claim against IEC consequent to environmental damage, as far as this damage or loss result from the supply of the lead batteries object of this contract, and as far as this damage or loss results from this activity and negligence of the supplier following this contract.

Appendix 1

Bidder's declaration on hazardous materials handling permit for the supply of lead batteries

1. I, the undersigned, _____ am the CEO \ marketing manager \ the legal counsellor of the company _____ (henceforth "the bidder"). In my aforementioned capacity, I am authorized to give this declaration in the name of the bidder.
2. This declaration supports the bid that has been submitted by me / the bidder as part of tender for the supply of hazardous material (henceforth "the bid" and "the bidder").
3. I am familiar with the details of the bid and with the requirements of the law regarding the products specified in the bid, as being "hazardous materials" according to the applicable definitions and regulations.
4. I hereby declare that the bidder has all the permits required by law, on behalf of all the relevant government entities and authorities, including complete permit for handling lead batteries for all the relevant articles regarding the activity of the bidder and / or the tender, as follows: import, commerce, transportations (conveying, transport), issue, marketing, storage.
5. Furthermore, in case that the bidder wins the tender and for any reason, whatsoever, he or his subcontractors, which are employed by him, fail to provide all the required permits from any authority and/or official entity, domestic or overseas, required in order to manufacturer and/or transportation, and/or any form of handling of the batteries, the bidder obligates to inform the IEC immediately, and it would constitute a fundamental breach of the order condition, with all implications.
6. The bidder is aware of and accepts that the IEC may, at any time, demand to provide all the aforementioned permits (including permit for handling hazardous materials, of all the relevant order's clauses), or part of them.

As above mentions, failing to present the permits, is considered to be a fundamental breach of the order conditions, by the bidder.

1. I, the undersigned _____, serving as the CEO / Vice President / _____ (fulfillment of another position) of the _____ Company (hereinafter: "the Bidder"), by virtue of my position as stated above, I am hereby authorized to present this declaration in the name of the Bidder.
2. This declaration comes to support the bid that has been offered by myself/ by the Bidder, in the framework of the Tender for the Supply of lead batteries, in correlation with the above tender, the Bidder will include, without any additional cost to the IEC, and will efficiently carry out, in accordance with the requirements of the law, the removal of the used/damaged batteries to an "Approved Site" for recycling factory, approved by the Ministry of Environmental Protection.
3. In the event that the Bidder is awarded the tender, the Bidder shall notify IEC the Name, address, contact person of the "Approved Site".
4. In the event that the Bidder is awarded the tender and for any reason whatsoever, he and/ or the sub-contractors do not have the permits and certificates in their possession for the repeated use or the absorption of hazardous waste on behalf of any authority and/ or official entity in Israel or abroad, that are required as a condition for any type of handling of empty containers of hazardous materials, the Bidder undertakes to immediately notify the IEC of this, and the undersigned agrees in advance in the name of the bidder, that this matter will constitute a significant breach of the conditions of the order by the Bidder, with all of the implications there of.
5. Non-removal of used/damaged lead Batteries as said, to the approved site or for recycling use, will constitute a fundamental breach of the conditions of the order by the Bidder.
6. The undersigned hereby agrees in advance, in the name of the Bidder, that the IEC will be allowed, at any time, to request the provision of certifications of acceptance at the designated site for used/damaged Batteries (including the Hazardous Material Permit of the site accepting the used/damaged Batteries), or part of these.
